Located inside Milan Innovation District MIND, Human Technopole (HT) is a large-scale, government-funded, research infrastructure that contributes to improving human health and well-being by developing new approaches to personalized and preventive medicine.




- Assolombarda has over 6.800 member companies that operate in Milan, Monza & Brianza and Lodi areas, which employ around 357.000 professionals


